

Carbon Emissions

We are committed to being Net Zero by 2050, which is in line with the Welsh government's target, and CO2e is a key focus area for us.

Our successes include:

- Phase one of our refrigeration replacement activity has seen us nearly eliminate refrigerant gas usage by saving more than 93 tonnes
- Repurposing the Bwydlyn building, saving more than 47 tonnes of CO2e
- Saving more than 10 tonnes of carbon emissions by avoiding landfill
- Installing engineless refrigeration on six HGVs, saving more than 80 tonnes of CO2e
- Producing and reporting environmental KPIs that include all three scopes, allowing us to measure carbon reduction and success in hitting objectives



Supply Chain

Our aim is to meet the needs of all our customers and be regarded as the most reliable and efficient foodservice supplier in Wales and the North West.

- Ensuring our supply chain operate in line with The Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO), Red Tractor, and MSC best practices
- Working on plastic reduction with The Country Range Group and Socius
- Securing accreditations and certificates including STS Food Safety, Green Dragon, and RSPO, of which we are a member
- Working with a supply chain that centres around the need to be as local as possible to any client and therefore keeping overall food mileage at a minimum
- Stocking a wide range of Fairtrade and eco-friendly products
- Supplying water machines with reusable water bottles for all staff and visitors
